



Contributions and Charges 2023

CONTRIBUTIONS:

In accordance with Department of Education Contributions, Charges and Fees Policy January 2010, schools can request up to a maximum contribution of \$60.00 for Years K-6.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table beneath. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Government.

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CHARGES

The term “Charges” refers to the provision of extra cost optional activities which are part of an educational program and which contributions do not cover. All of the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with similar outcome will be provided to that student.

The 2023 extra cost optional activities, which have been approved by Wandering School Council, are as follows. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed this amount. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.

Please Note: Payment for the following charges is not required at the time of paying your contributions. Where staff arrange extra curricula activities, payment will be requested prior to the event.

The \$1000 is for costs towards:

Payment options:

Parents may consider a Progressive Payment Option where Contributions, Charges and Additional Requests can be paid off. The “Charges” component does not have to be paid in full at the beginning of the year.

We encourage all parents and families to utilise the progressive payment option to enable all students to participate in all school events.

The school will endeavour to give as much notice as possible to parents for extra optional activities. Parents do not have to pay all of the Contributions and Charges at the time of notification.

Refund of Contributions and Charges:

If a student transfers to another school, arrangements will be made to forward a pro-rata portion of their “Contributions” to their new school. Alternatively, a refund can be arranged.
