Dear Parents/Carers/Guardians,

The Wandering School Council has recently endorsed the *Schedule of Contributions and Charges* for 2026. This information is provided now so you may organise your finances in preparation for 2026.

CONTRIBUTIONS:

Following the Department of Education Contributions, Charges, and Fees Policy of January 2010, schools can request up to a maximum contribution of \$60.00 for Years K-6.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditures in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table below. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

CHARGES:

The term "Charges" refers to the provision of extra cost optional activities which are part of an educational program and which contributions do not cover. All the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with a similar outcome will be provided to that student.

The 2026 extra cost optional activities, which have been approved by Wandering School Council, are as follows. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed this amount. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.

Please Note: Payment for the following charges is not required at the time of paying your contributions. Where staff arranges extra curricula activities, payment will be requested prior to the event.

Excursions and Incursions

Up to 4 excursions per year – These could include excursions to Williams, Boddington, Narrogin, Pingelly, Wickepin, and Perth.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Parents may consider a Payment Option where Contributions, Charges and Additional Requests can be paid off. The "Charges" component does not have to be paid in full at the beginning of the year.

We encourage all parents and families to utilise the payment option to enable all students to participate in all school events. Should you wish to set up a payment plan, please contact the school office for the application form.

If a student transfers to another school, arrangements will be made to forward a pro–rata portion of their "Contributions" to their new school. Alternatively, a refund can be arranged.
